- **2. Approval of the Minutes** February 14, 2017; Motion to accept by Lilianna Perez-Lefevre/seconded by Shawni MacPherson
- 3. Principal's Report Troy White
 - We for She—Hosting Student run conference (April 13), initiated by kids thru Global initiative club. Gave presentation to parliament, 50 students to raise awareness to gender issues. 5 schools -250 kids.
 - End of Term: April 19 New Term starts after Easter
 - April 24-26 KSS selling prom tickets
 - Non-grad walk list has gone up—issue with grad process, doesn't mean not graduating. If they don't have credits then don't graduate.
 - April 26 Map presentation—early dismissal
 - KSS ahead of things—curriculum includes new careers so picking classes after grade 10
 perfect time due to Grade 10 extensions of planning—help kids plan early. Other high
 schools not there yet.
 - Budget meeting next Thursday. Discussion about wording for 2002 Teacher's
 agreement and SD23 composition clause. Will discuss ramifications at budget meeting.
 Also up for discussion: 7 new teachers next year—can spread out designated kids.
 Some teachers want to team teach. Teachers won't have rooms for prep—will have to prep in teachers lounge.
 - April 26-29th—Theatre production Frogs
 - Student council raising money for Giggles Foundation—Dodgeball competition May 4th:
 2 tournaments before and finals at KSS May 4th
 - May 4th LINK sign up and training. WEB targets grades 6-8. LINK targets students entering grade 9/10. Training grade 12's and some grade 11's for LINK. Some concern over time of training—in finals week.
 - Teachers retiring: Joanne Taylor (April 1), Cathy Heymen, Phil Lewis, Patti Buna, Sally McRoberts, Jasmine Lemon—VP, Bridget Kamp—maternity. Hiring soon.
 - SPC -- decision soon, in inquiry process, instead of goals—scanning process. Why are kids not coming to school? do they feel connected? Teachers generated questionnaire—about 180 questions. Narrowed down questions and picked 5 which show how kids at KSS are learning. Preliminary questions—asked 200-300 kids—collated info. Each department came up with inquiry question; how to improve student learning, connectedness—at some point will scan/include parents. Slow process—completely different. Posting it online—Learning Plan. This is at the District level.
