We will have a Homeroom at 9:00 am each morning for the first week of school only, where teachers will assign lockers, collect fees and distribute information to take home. SCHOOL FEES

The fastest and easier way to pay school fees is on-line. The \$30.00 Activity Fee has been added to all students.

An optional \$10.00 Parking Pass Fee has been added to all Grade 12 students, and is only for those who wish to purchase a parking pass. Applications for a Parking Pass can be picked up at the office and are also available on our website. Please bring the COMPLETED Parking Pass Application and proof of payment of both the Parking Pass Fee and Activity Fee to Mr. Labrie in the MPR at **8:00 AM** on **Thursday, September 7th** for processing. Parking passes are available to Grade 12 students only.

The \$75.00 Early Bird Grade 12 Graduation Ceremony Fee has been added to Grade 12 students and expires December 31st. The fee will go up to \$85.00 in January.

Opportunity to purchase a Yearbook has also been popped on to student accounts in order to take advantage of early bird pricing. Please log on to your child's account at School Cash Online to see the options available. It is strongly suggested that all fees are paid on-line as an automatic receipt is generated and proof of payment is always available .

Extra-Curricular Activities

Activities at Kelowna Secondary get underway very quickly! Students need to listen for announcements as well as check our message board for info on sports tryouts, clubs, etc. We have a large electronic message board in our Multi Purpose Area as well as in the Library Commons on the second floor. Announcements are read daily over the PA system.

COURSE CHANGES

Timetable changes will only be made for the following reasons:

- 1) Grade 12 student needs a course change for post-secondary or graduation.
- 2) A student has failed a required course and needs to re-take it.
- 3) A Grade 10 student who does not have a full schedule
- 4) A student is needing a different level of English, Math and/or Science.

The Counseling Centre will call down students by grade and alpha, starting with Grade 12's the week of September 11—September 15. September 15 is the last day for course changes.
