JUNE ASSESSMENTS

Students graduating with a Dogwood Diploma in B.C. are required to complete Numeracy 10, Literacy 10, and Literacy 12 assessments. The Literacy 10 and Math 10 assessments are available to be written in Math 10 Classes and English 10 courses in November, January and April each year. The Literacy 12 assessments are written in class in January and April.

Grade 11-12 students who have missed previous assessments, have **make-up sessions on Monday, June 8th and Tuesday, June 9th.** These students have been notified of next week's schedule.

Any students in grade 10 that missed their assessments in the earlier sessions, will be contacted in the fall to attend an assessment make-up session in November.

April Assessment marks are now visible in the MyEd Student Portal.
