



Grad Winter Formal



PARKING AT KSS

At KSS, parking is at a minimum, and the lots are monitored. To avoid a warning sticker on your windshield, and/or to avoid your vehicle being towed, please follow the guidelines below.

<u>PARENTS</u>: Student pick-up and drop-off is in the <u>Student/Visitor Parking lot</u>. DO NOT USE STAFF PARKING LOTS TO DROP-OFF OR PICK-UP STUDENTS.

There are not enough staff parking stalls for all staff, itinerant staff, TTOCs and volunteers. If you are parking in the Staff Lot, you must be registered and have a KSS Staff Parking sticker.

<u>VISITORS:</u> Park in designated Visitor stalls in the <u>Student/Visitor Parking Lot.</u> Please come to the main office to register your vehicle and receive a parking pass.


