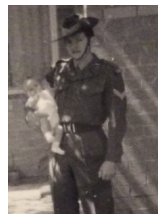

DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM—YOUTH TRAIN IN TRADES

The Central Okanagan Public Schools provide post-secondary program options to high school students that allow students the opportunity to begin post-secondary training while in high school. Students will earn post-secondary credentials that will also give them credit towards their high school graduation.

High school students can begin taking post-secondary programs/courses in trades and technical training, health and human services, and first-year university transfer courses in Arts, Science, and Engineering.
