#### Parking & Student Drop-off / Pick-up


Grade 12 students must only park in the indicated Grade 12 student parking areas. A parking pass must be displayed. Grade 12 parking passes are still available.

The Visitor Parking is in the Student Parking Lot. Please remember to pick up a visitor parking pass from the office.


<u>Parents</u> dropping off or picking up are to <u>use the Visitor / Student Parking</u> lot to ensure the safety of our staff and students.

Simply bring your containers to the depot in sealed, TRANSPARENT BLUE or CLEAR BAGS, and enter the KSS grad class number at the Express kiosk. You will be prompted to select the number of bags you're dropping off, and the kiosk will automatically print stickers for each of your bags with the KSS Grad Express account code. Tag each of your bags with a sticker, and drop the bags off in the designated Express drop-off area to be counted and credited to our account. (Note: a maximum of 12 alass bottles can be included in each bag.)

Dear Parents/guardians.

Each year the KSS PAC provides 2 bursaries and 2 scholarships of \$1000 each to KSS graduates who will be attending post-secondary education in the Fall of their graduating year.
