- Students must grant access to their STS transcripts after applying
- Early offers to non-selective programs as early as late November/early December
- BSc. Kinesiology grade 12 admission requirement change to:
 - English Studies 12 or English First Peoples 12 with at least 67%
 - Pre-calculus 12
 - Two approved science 12 courses (Anatomy and Physiology 12 and Physics 12 are recommended)

- First year housing guarantee applies to students entering UVic directly from high school who apply for residence by the deadline (May 1st). Applications open February 3rd.

- Our Aviation programs, the [Bachelor of Business Administration \(Aviation\) degree](#) and [Business Administration \(Aviation\) diploma](#), no longer require Physics.
- The [Automation and Robotics Technician diploma](#) and [Digital Manufacturing diploma](#) no longer require completion of the Electronics Technician certificate for entrance (can be applied to directly from high school).

Campus Changes

- UFV's Mission campus, designed in partnership with local Mission Stó:lō community leaders, has opened and the Fall 2024 cohort of the Bachelor of Education degree will be taking place on Mission campus.

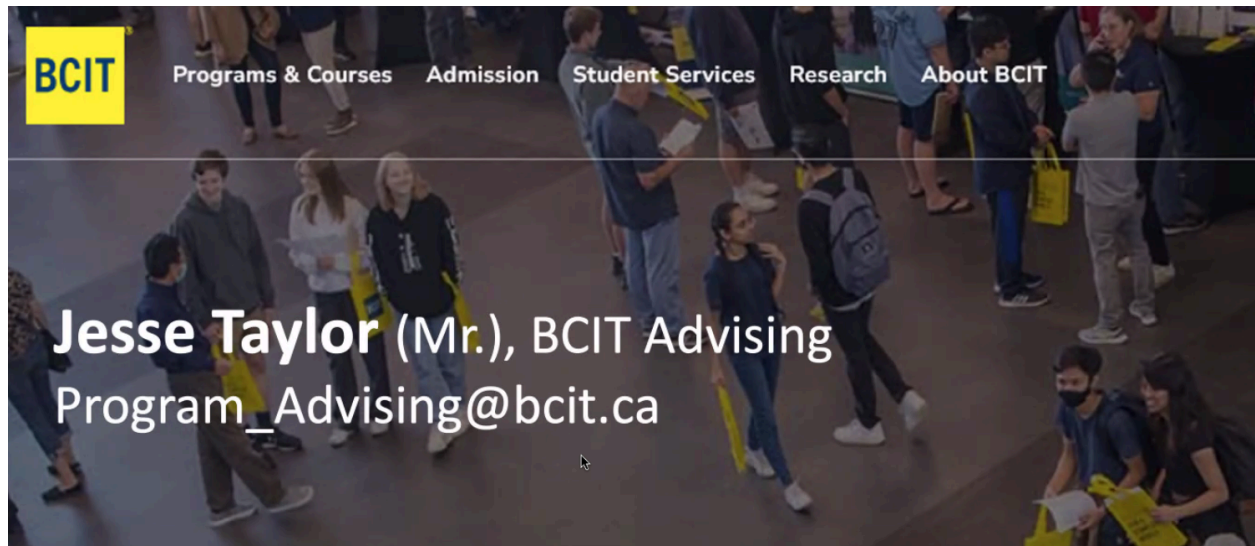

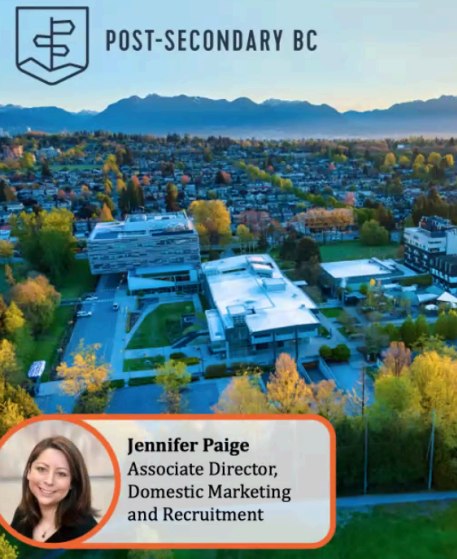

1st Year Prerequisites

English Requirements:

- Students applying to Open Enrolment programs can gain admission to the College with 50% English 12, but will then need to take an English upgrade at Langara in order to meet the first-year English requirement.
- The English requirement to some limited Enrolment programs is 70%.

BC Transcript Service

- For students who graduated from a BC High School, send your transcripts directly to Langara via the Student Transcript Service on the Ministry of Education website. We are unable to accept transcripts not sent directly from the Ministry of Education.

Nursing Entry from High School

- Apply to the Foundation in Health Studies program.
- Students will need English 12, Chemistry 11, Anatomy and Physiology 12, and one of Precalculus 11, Precalculus 12, Foundations of Math 11, Foundations of Math 12 to meet prerequisite requirements.
