

Program Changes

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree now requires Casper score instead of interview and essay.
- Engineering Common Core certificate launched (formerly known as the Engineering Transfer Program).
- Formerly suspended Indigenous Maps, Films, Rights, and Land Claims certificate reimplemented as Power and Place: Stó:lō Téméxw Responsibility, Reflection, and (Re)Storying associate certificate.

Entrance Requirement Changes

- Bachelor of Regional and Community Planning degree can now be applied to directly from high school (no longer requires university-level credit for entrance).
- Our Aviation programs, the Bachelor of Business Administration (Aviation) degree and Business Administration (Aviation) diploma, no longer require Physics.
- The Automation and Robotics Technician diploma and Digital Manufacturing diploma no longer require completion of the Electronics Technician certificate for entrance (can be applied to directly from high school).

Campus Changes

- UFV's Mission campus, designed in partnership with local Mission Stó:lō community leaders, has opened and the Fall 2024 cohort of the Bachelor of Education degree will be taking place on Mission campus.
- We've broken ground on our new student housing building, which will house an additional 398 students and is expected to open for occupancy in Fall 2025. As part of this, the cafeteria expansion & renovation is also underway and expected to reopen for Fall 2025.
