BURSARY APPLICATION 2023**

Applicants must graduate from KSS in 2023 and attend a full-time provincially authorized post-secondary institution in the Fall of 2023 (visit <https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/education-training/post-secondary-education/find-a-program-or-institution>). To qualify financially, please indicate the range of combined household income (from T4 slips for 2022 earnings and/or line 150 on the Canada Revenue Agency personal income tax filing) for the adults who currently support you.
