## How do I find my Homeroom?

- Students will find their Homeroom on their Student Schedule. Schedules will be published to the MyEd Parent Portal next week. Homerooms may also be found in the MyEd Parent Portal, "Family" top tab, "Demographics".
- Your Homeroom Number is the Classroom Number. Example: Homeroom 179 is Classroom # 179.
- If you do not have a homeroom, please come to the main office.
- Each morning of the first week (Sept 2-5) will begin with a Homeroom at 9:00 a.m. Attendance is taken and important information will be distributed.

#### **COURSE CHANGE REQUESTS**

Students must attend their scheduled classes listed on their timetable the first week of school, even if they have a request for course change submitted. Requests for course changes may possibly be granted (if space allows) for the following reasons: missing course, missing Indigenous course, missing grad requirement, courses are not in correct sequence, semesters are not balanced.

New students that have an <u>accepted registration</u> may come to the KSS Career Centre on August 25 or August 27 between 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m., for course selection. For students that completed an Enrolment Application or are waitlisted, <u>IF</u> your application is accepted, you will be contacted for your course selection at that time.

Returning students, and incoming Grade 10s from catchment middle schools, that did NOT fill out the Course Change Request online form, may request a course change in person at the KSS Career Centre the week of August 25-29 during the hours listed below (with the exception of Aug 25 & 27 a.m.).

KSS Career Centre hours August 25-29 are: 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. Course requests will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis and only for the reasons listed above.

The main office opens on Monday, August 25, with regular hours 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

#### **MEDICAL ALERTS**

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform the school of a Student's Medical Alert. Please come to the office to complete the appropriate Medical Forms. Epi-Pens and medication may be kept in the school Medical Room if appropriate documentation is on file. These documents must be submitted/reviewed and signed yearly.

#### STUDENT FEES

#### **ACTIVITY FEE**

The required Cultural/Activity Student Fee for 2025-2026 is \$30.00 per student. All **school fees** (cultural/activity, field studies, courses, yearbook, etc.) **are paid online via SchoolCash Online**—link is <u>HERE</u>.

Central Okanagan School District's Financial Hardship Clause—Within Board Regulation 425R – Student Fees (see www.sd23.bc.ca), the Board of Education has indicated "that a student will not be excluded from any educational program due to financial hardship". Clause 8.5 in the Regulations states "Principals are directed to establish a procedure in each school which will allow for the private and confidential consideration of financial circumstances of individual students and families. Such procedures will preserve the dignity of families who may be unable to pay". Please contact your Alpha VP if you are facing a financial hardship that may restrict the ability of your child to access a school program.

#### **YEARBOOK**

An *optional* Yearbook fee has been added to student School Cash Online student accounts. The deadline for early bird pricing is December 1st. The final deadline to purchase a yearbook is February 28<sup>th</sup>. Extra copies are not printed.

#### PARKING PASS - Grade 12 only

An optional \$15.00 Grade 12 Parking Pass Fee has been added to all Grade 12 students. This is optional and only for those who wish to purchase a parking pass. Parking passes are available to Grade 12 students only and do not guarantee a parking spot, only the permission to park if a spot is available. To receive the parking permit, students must bring a receipt for the \$15.00 fee to the office along with the "2025-2026 Student Parking Policy Contract" (signed by a parent) and fill out the "Parking Registration" google form. All forms may be found on KSS Website, under "Students".

#### STUDENT PHOTOS

Student Photo Day is scheduled for Friday, September 12. Re-takes are scheduled for Monday, October 6. All students will receive a complimentary ID card and photos will be in the KSS Yearbook. Photos may be purchased online through Artona.

#### STUDENT ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

At KSS, in-class attendance is expected. Notes are not accepted to excuse absences, sign out or leave early. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to report absences, lates and early departures using School Messenger - Safe Arrival Absence Reporting system.

#### REPORTING

School Messenger - Safe Arrival may be accessed three ways:

- (1) School Messenger App (most user friendly).
- (2) Online Parent Portal: go.schoolmessenger.ca.
- (3) Call the School at 250-870-5105 and press "1".

#### **LATES**

Students that are <u>more than 30 minutes late</u> for class must check in at the office. The office will timestamp the student's arrival. Once the student makes their way to their classroom, their teacher will change the Absence to a Late. If this is an excused late, parents may report this in Safe Arrival. Parents may contact the classroom teacher for attendance inquiries.

#### **EARLY DEPARTURES**

Parents may report early departures in Safe Arrival. Once reported, the teacher will see this in MyEd and release the student at the reported dismissal time. If there is no excused absence in MyEd, students will be sent to the office for follow-up. This may delay student dismissal as the office obtains parental approval. If no parental approval is obtained, the student will be sent back to class.



#### **MYED PARENT PORTAL**

KSS utilizes the MyEd Parent Portal. Student Schedules, Student Verification Reports, Student Written Learning Updates, etc. are published to the MyEd Parent Portal.

New parents/guardians will receive an email with a temporary Login ID and password. You will need both to login to MyEd the first time.

#### **TEXTBOOKS**

Certain classes may utilize Textbooks. In this case, textbooks will be signed out to each individual student. Students are responsible for the textbook that has been signed out to them and must return it, in good condition, at the end of the course. Students will be charged for a replacement cost if the textbook signed out to them is not returned.

#### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The KSS Code of Conduct will be reviewed with students during their Homeroom next week. #### Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page <a href="https://centralokanagan.schoolcashonline.com/">https://centralokanagan.schoolcashonline.com/</a> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps
   \*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

#### Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

#### Step 3: Find Student

Note: Student Number is Not Required

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name
- b) Enter the School Name
- c) Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- d) Select Continue
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*
- f) Your child has been added to your account

#### Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account.

If you do not wish to add additional children, select

"View Items for Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.
