2025-2026 Course Requests Deadline is Friday, February 28th.



KSS PARKING PROCEDURES



The arrows indicate the **Student Parking Lots.**Student parking is first come, first serve and all vehicles must have registered and have a parking pass displayed.

The arrows also represent the <u>Visitor (Parent) Parking</u> area, which is located in the <u>Student Parking Lot</u>. Please remember to pick up a visitor parking pass from the office.

This is also the area designated for student drop off and pick up.



Each year the KSS PAC provides 2 bursaries and 2 scholarships of \$1000 each to KSS graduates who will be attending post-secondary education in the Fall of their graduating year. The bursaries/scholarships are awarded to students based on financial need, academic achievement, and a desire to pursue post-secondary education in Canada.

Previously, these were funded through KSS's annual provincial community gaming grant, however, gaming funds are no longer allowed to be used for bursaries and scholarships. Hence, the PAC must fundraise in order to continue to provide these funds to support KSS students in their future education.
