

ATTENDANCE

Parents/Guardians are required to report absences using the **School Messenger** - Safe Arrival Absence Reporting system. *Please do not call the main office*.

The System can be accessed three ways:

- (1) Enter an Absence Using the **School Messenger App** (most user-friendly process)
- (2) Enter an Absence Using the Online Parent Portal go.schoolmessenger.ca



(3) Enter an Absence by Calling the School 250-870-5105, press "1" and follow the prompts

IMPORTANT:

- Notes are not accepted at the office to either excuse absences or to sign students out.
- Students will <u>not</u> be released from school unless permission has been granted via the above process by a parent/guardian.

GRADE 12 PARKING PASS

An <u>optional</u> \$10.00 Parking Pass Fee has been added to all **Grade 12 students**, and is only for those who wish to purchase a parking pass. Parking passes are available to Grade 12 students only **and do not guarantee a parking spot**, **only the permission to park if a spot is available**.

Listen for announcements next week for details! To receive a Parking Pass you must have:

- ⇒ Paid the \$10.00 fee on School Cash Online and have your receipt with you
- ⇒ Grade 12 Student Parking Policy Contract signed by a parent/guardian with you
- ⇒ Completed the Parking Registration Google Form <u>HERE</u>

Kelowna Secondary School - Student Parking Policy Contract

NOTE: Each year there are over **600** Grade 12's and only **159** student parking spots.

This Parking Permit gives students the permission to park in the Kelowna Secondary School

e done on a daily 'first come, first served' basis, and if there are no parking spots available then udents will have to park somewhere other than at KSS at their own risk. The \$10 fee simply covers a cost of the pass.				
By initialling below the student agrees that they will not park in the Staff Parking Lot, the Visitor Parking Area, in a Fire Lane or other traffic corridors. Students recognize if they park improperly, parking discipline procedures will be enforced.

I, the undersigned, do agree that by signing this Parking Policy Contract I understand:				
> That all outstanding student / school fees must be paid prior to obtaining a parking pass.				
That I will face progressive parking enforcement, should I violate any aspect of this Parking Policy Contract. (please see next page for progression of parking enforcement)				
That Parking Permits are for Grade 12 students only and may not be given or sold to any other person. Doing so will result in my parking permit being revoked for the year.				
> That each Parking Permit costs \$10.00, and if I lose my pass there will be a replacement cost.				
That School District #23 and Kelowna Secondary School are not responsible for damage done to vehicles in the school parking lots. I park at my own risk.				
> That I must display my Parking Permit on my rear-view mirror at all times when parked in the Student Parking Lot in order to make it visible from outside the vehicle.				

- > That while in my vehicle on school grounds, I will abide by the KSS Code of Conduct.
- That I will not "hang out' or loiter in my car while it is parked at KSS.
- > That my Parking Permit may be revoked without refund if: a) I do not follow safe driving practices at all times, b) I consume alcohol or smoke in my vehicle while on school grounds, c) I make the parking lot a mess – litter, etc. d) violate any other terms of this contract.
- > That I must update the office, should the details of my vehicle change (add a new car, change a license plate number, etc.




