Dear community member,

On behalf of the graduating class of 2026 and this year's grad council at Kelowna Secondary School, we would like to request donations to help fund and execute this year's upcoming graduation/prom. If you do not require a tax receipt, a cheque can be made to KELOWNA SECONDARY SCHOOL attention KSS PROM.





Dear Parents/guardians.

Each year the KSS PAC provides bursaries and scholarships to KSS graduates who will be attending post-secondary education in the Fall of their graduating year. The bursaries/scholarships are awarded to students based on financial need, academic achievement, and a desire to pursue post-secondary education in Canada.

Previously, these were funded through KSS's annual provincial community gaming grant, however, gaming funds are no longer allowed to be used for bursaries and scholarships. Hence, the PAC must fundraise in order to continue to provide these funds to support KSS students in their future education.

This is where YOU come in!

Please consider donating! Any amount, no matter how large or small, makes a difference!

Our fundraising goal is \$4,000 to cover the awards for 2026 & 2027 graduates as well as for teacher appreciation, and on-going PAC operating expenses.

How to donate

We have decided to use the school district donation option this year for our fundraiser. It allows us to keep all of the money that you donate, rather than having to pay platform fees, and gives you a tax receipt. **WIN-WIN!**

Steps:

1. Go to www.schoolcashonline.com and sign-in using your credentials that you pay your school fees with
2. Click *Make a Donation* to open the donation form
3. Choose *Kelowna Secondary*
4. In the message box write *KSS PAC Fund*
5. *Add to Cart* to go to the payment page
