SEMESTER TURN AROUND


Semester 1 / Quarter 2 ends on Friday, January 24th.





Dear Parents/guardians.

Each year the KSS PAC provides 2 bursaries and 2 scholarships of \$1000 each to KSS graduates who will be attending post-secondary education in the Fall of their graduating year.
