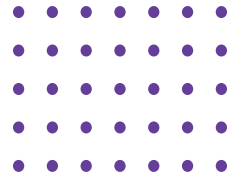
There will be multiple volunteering opportunities such as set-up and take-down, sign-in desk, route marshalls, snack/beverage table, cheerleaders, photographers, etc.
