We look forward to seeing grads and their loved ones for the traditional graduation promenade tonight! We will meet at the Dolphins Statue, 1200 Water Street, at **4:30 p.m.** The walk will begin at 5:00 p.m. sharp.

All prom attendees must board a school bus at Prospera Place to move to the evening venue, Sunset Ranch Golf and Country Club. Check-in and security checks will happen BEFORE loading, and no one who arrives independently will be admitted. Students will receive wristbands before boarding buses which will act as their "tickets" for the evening. **Grads must present photo ID** when checking in–student cards, learners/drivers licenses, BCID, etc. We must fill all buses to adult capacity before they leave, so grads may not be with their friend groups for the drive. We thank all grads for keeping the transportation smooth and safe. At the end of the evening, students have two options to return home. They can arrange their own pick-up from Sunset Ranch, or they can return via school bus. The DJ will announce bus departure times.

The event at Sunset Ranch is for grads and volunteers only. Parents—please do not come to the venue to see your grads both for capacity and security concerns.
