KSS PARKING LOTS

As the weather turns cold, we would like to remind you of the parking procedures at KSS. Please refer to the map below.

Students utilizing the **Student Parking Lot** must have a parking pass displayed on their vehicle's rear-view mirror and be parked in a **student parking spot**. Student parking is first come, first served.

Parents/guardians utilizing the **Visitor Parking Lot** must have a visitor parking pass displayed. Please see the main office for a pass. Visitor parking stalls are not for student drop off or pick up.

The Student / Visitor Parking Lot is designated for <u>drive-through student drop off and pick up</u> to ensure the safety of our staff and students.

Parents/Visitors ARE NOT TO USE the Staff Parking Lot for student drop off or pick up at ANY time.

COOL WEATHER


