2023 Commencement Ceremonies

On Saturday, June 10, grads will need to arrive at KSS 45 minutes before their ceremony time.



Students with last names beginning with A-K- arrive at 9:15am and go straight to the library. Students with last names beginning with L-Z, arrive at 12:45pm and go straight to the library.

Main doors will open 30 minutes early for viewers to find seating in time for the ceremonies to begin at 10am and 1:30pm sharp. The majority of our seating will be on bleachers. You are welcome to bring a cushion or sport seat if you have them. For any families requiring wheelchair-accessible seating, please contact dayna.culham@sd23.bc.ca and we will reserve floor seating.

It is expected that viewers will remain for the entire ceremony to honour all graduates and minimize disruption.

There are NO tickets required to attend KSS cap and gown ceremonies, but we ask that families consider that each ceremony is celebrating 300 grads, and to be mindful when bringing large families.
